Model 290

The Model 290 UHF datalink transponder enables reliable command, control, and telemetry communications between the ground control station and the flight vehicle's autopilot.

Qualified to MIL-STD-810, the UHF Transponder is designed to support harsh avionic environments while maintaining reliable, essential communications. It also has three antenna ports to support multiple antenna inputs via the vehicle RF switch. Multiple antenna inputs can be toggled through for the strongest signal.
